Sheep Market Report

3RD SEPTEMBER 2025 - A YARDING OF 3,209 SHEEP & LAMBS, WITH 2,819 LAMBS AND THE BALANCE SHEEP.

Numbers eased by nearly 1,000 head this sale. All major processors were present and competed in a stronger market compared to last sale. Only a few pens of old-season extra heavy lambs were offered, topping at \$397 and selling \$5-\$12 dearer. Heavy lambs followed a similar trend, selling around \$5 either side of firm. Medium lambs to process saw a slight slip, with some sales \$5 cheaper, while light lambs were generally firm to \$5 easier, with quality and finish influencing price variations.

Merino lambs with weight reached a top of \$300, while the 3-4 score Merinos were \$15-\$20 dearer on last sale. The best pen of crossbred hoggets sold to \$243.

Mutton numbers were limited but quality remained high with plenty of well-finished sheep on offer. The best crossbred ewes topped at \$250, with most 3-4 score ewes selling \$10-\$30 dearer. Merino ewes and wethers reached \$242, with those carrying weight, finish, and skin \$30-\$35 dearer. Rams sold from \$220-\$236 across all breeds with weight.

Cattle Market Report

3RD SEPTEMBER 2025 - 950 CATTLE YARDED

This fortnight's fat sale yarded 950 head, with a strong and even yarding throughout. Feeder steers saw improved competition, with the best reaching 540c/kg, up 20c/kg on last sale. Heifers followed a similar trend, topping at 414c/kg, up 10c/kg. There was a good run of heavy cattle, with the best steers selling to 500c/kg, up to 15c/kg, while the top heifers reached 478c/kg, up 5c/kg. Cows sold to strong demand, with the best making 420c/kg, lifting 20c/kg. An excellent yarding of bulls also saw solid competition, with the top bull selling to 419.2c/kg.

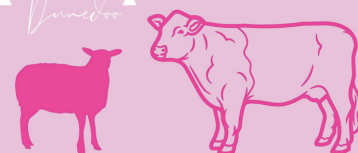
