Sheep Market Report 11th december 2024 - a yarding of 2,708 sheep & lambs, with 1,647 lambs and the balance sheep.

The final yarding for 2024 saw an increase in numbers, with plenty of well-finished sheep and lambs on offer. All major processors were present and actively competing in a stronger market across all categories. Extra-heavy lambs kicked off the sale on a high note, reaching a top price of \$305 per head, marking a \$20-30 increase compared to the previous sale. Heavy lambs followed suit, showing a \$20-25 rise, with neatly shorn new-season lambs topping at \$285 per head. Medium lambs were \$5-10 dearer than the last sale, while light lambs traded around firm levels. New-season suckers achieved a top price of \$240 per head, reflecting a \$10-20 improvement. Merino lamb numbers were limited this fortnight, with the market holding firm based on weight and quality. Heavy and light sheep attracted significant competition, with plenty of heavy 3-4 score ewes

Cattle Market Report

11TH DECEMBER 2024 - 710 CATTLE YARDED

The final sale of the year saw 950 head yarded, featuring an outstanding run of yearling and feeder cattle. The top pen of feeder steers reached 387.2c/kg, with many others achieving similar prices across all breeds, making the job 17c/kg dearer. The best feeder heifers peaked at 334.2c/kg, with most selling for over 300c/kg. Heavy heifers were in limited supply, with the top pen also selling at 334.2c/kg, reflecting a 15c/kg improvement on the previous sale. Heavy steers topped at 348.0c/kg, holding firm compared to the last sale. Meanwhile, the best cows reached 305.2c/kg, pushing the market up by 25c/kg, with strong competition across all categories.
