Sheep Market Report

17TH SEPTEMBER 2025 - A YARDING OF 3,833 SHEEP & LAMBS, WITH 2,896 LAMBS AND THE BALANCE SHEEP.

Numbers lifted this fortnight with more new season suckers yarded. All major processors were in attendance and competed in a market that was either side of firm. Extra heavy lambs were limited, with only a few pens to quote, and sold firm on last sale. Heavy lambs sold \$10-\$15 dearer, with some new season shorn lambs included in this category. Medium lambs followed a similar trend, also selling \$10-\$15 dearer. Light lambs to process were stronger, with some sales up to \$18 dearer. Merino lambs were of excellent quality and in good numbers, with most well-finished pens selling either side of firm, ranging \$5-\$10 easier or dearer depending on quality. The best of the crossbred hoggets reached a top of \$260. Mutton numbers were similar to last sale. The best pen of crossbred ewes sold to \$260, up \$10-\$15 on last sale. Merino ewes topped at \$220, showing a slight price correction of \$10-\$15 easier. The best ram reached \$200.

17TH SEPTEMBER 2025 - 950 CATTLE YARDED

We saw a very good yarding this week across all grades. Feeder steers topped at 542.2c/kg, firm on last sale, while the best of the feeder heifers reached 500c/kg, also firm. Heavy steers were stronger again this week, with an outstanding run seeing a top price of 517.2c/kg, up 30c/kg. The best heavy heifers sold to 480c/kg, firm on last sale. The cow market was very strong, with the top cows making 428c/kg, up 30c/kg. Bulls also saw excellent competition, with the best reaching 442.2c/kg, up 20c/kg.

Well done to the O'Leary family and thank you to all who attended and supported the sale.



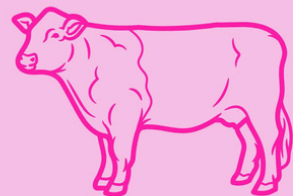
Congratulations to Zane, Emma, and Stevie Ryan on a fantastic first ram sale on Monday 15th September!
